A group of "Jewish pioneers" met in a church in Palm Beach Gardens and **imagined** a future home that would give space to worship, to learn, to enjoy friendship and community. The group continued to grow and thrive, and just eight years later, in 1983, Temple Beth David opened their own doors, and became the first synagogue in the area, and a home for Jewish education and worship.

Continuing to grow, our congregation voted to expand our home. Since 2002, our original sanctuary has become a chapel for minyan and smaller services, Friday Tot Shabbats and programming for our schools. A new wing for Preschool and Religious Schools allows us to accommodate more children and more classes. The addition of a Social Hall provides ample seating for all holidays and the flexibility to have both small and large celebrations with our kosher kitchens. Our new lobby gives us another space for gathering and our Meditation Garden adds beauty and peace to our space.

Today, our families enjoy the beauty and spirituality of our sanctuary and its surroundings; learning and laughter, comfort and community are found throughout.
