Making a Difference.

This year, our Social Action committee came under the Sisterhood umbrella. Our focus has been on Tikkun Olum - repairing the world - in as many ways as we can. We have been successful in feeding those in need in our community through our support of St. George's Feeding Center in Riviera Beach and the South Florida Soup Kitchen and Assistance Foundation. 
